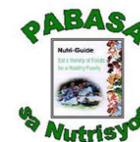




2018 *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* Awards Mechanics



The ***Pabasa sa Nutrisyon (PSN) Awards*** is an annual search of the **Nutrition Center of the Philippines (NCP)** for **government and non-government organizations** who have successfully implemented the *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* Program in their respective areas.

There are 4 awards:

- **2018 *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* Outstanding Award**

This award recognizes the outstanding implementation of *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* in their areas. This is open to all local government units (provinces, cities and municipalities) nationwide and to all non-government organizations that have adopted the program in the communities of their beneficiaries. This is awarded to all organizations that received a grade not less than **75%** from the *PSN Awards* Committee during evaluation of their application.

- **2018 *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* Exemplary Award**

This award recognizes government and non-government organizations that are successfully implementing *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* and have received a ***Pabasa sa Nutrisyon Outstanding Award*** in the last **two consecutive years**. Further, the organizations must receive a grade not less than **75%** from the *PSN Awards* Committee during evaluation of their application on their 3rd year.

- **2018 *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* Hall of Fame Award**

This award recognizes government and non-government organizations that received the ***Pabasa sa Nutrisyon Exemplary Award*** the previous year. Further, the organizations must receive a grade not less than **75%** from the *PSN Awards* Committee during evaluation of their application on their 4th year. Hall of Fame Awardees are no longer eligible for Outstanding and Exemplary Awards.

- **2018 *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* Diamond Award**

This award recognizes government and non-government organizations that received the ***Pabasa sa Nutrisyon Hall of Fame Award*** from 2012 and below. The award aims to recognize organizations that have continued to implement *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* program until 2017 after receiving the Hall of Fame Award. The organization must accomplish and submit the **Diamond Award Application Form**. Further, the organization must receive a grade not less than **80%** from the *PSN Awards* Committee during evaluation of their application.

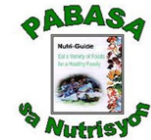
Mechanics

Applicants. Local government units from provincial to municipal levels as well as NGOs who have implemented ***Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* in 2017** can apply for the *PSN Awards*.

The **NCP *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon (PSN) Awards Committee*** will be the one to review and validate the *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon Awards Evaluation Form*. NCP *PSN Awards Committee* will only review the submitted Evaluation Form if the applicant has submitted the complete required and supporting documents on or before the submission deadline. Failure to submit the complete documents will result to disqualification. Awardees will be notified through an official letter from NCP at least 2 weeks prior to the Awarding Ceremony.



2018 *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* Awards Mechanics



Letters of endorsements from the **Provincial Nutrition Committee (PNC)** and/or the **Regional Nutrition Committee (RNC)** can be submitted as supporting documents. These are **optional documents** for the applicants but additional points will be given for those that will be able to submit.

Evaluation Guideline. Grading criteria include Program Scope (30%), Management Efficiency (30%), and Program Impact (40%).

The Program Scope includes the coverage of the *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* program, the target saturation (number and percentage of mothers with underweight and severely underweight children, pregnant mothers, and lactating mothers enrolled in *PSN*, and the *PSN* graduates.

Management Efficiency includes the strategic methods adopted during the implementation of the project with the following components described: process of identifying and gathering targets; venue, time, frequency and leaders of the *PSN* sessions; methods to assess the impact of the project; best practices observed in conducting the project; and documentation of the project.

The Program Impact will be gauged through the improvement in the nutritional status of children (underweight and severely underweight) and in the selected Program Output Indicators. The Program Output Indicators include the proportion of the following: women who exclusively breastfeed their child, 0 to <6 year old children who took vitamin A supplements, pregnant women who are taking iron-folic acid supplements, household with own fruits/vegetable garden, households with own fruits/vegetable garden, and households using iodized salt and/or fortified food.

Submission of Application Form and related documents. The accomplished *Pabasa sa Nutrisyon* Application Form and required and supporting documents must be **submitted online** at NCP's website (www.ncp.org.ph) on or before **May 31, 2018**. **Paper copies will no longer be accepted.**
